The kits includes the following items the following life saving components; CAT tourniquet Emergency bandage, Latex gloves, Trauma shears, Permanent marker, and Printed instructions They have been installed in the following four locations through out the club facility. Main entrance of the club house Inside the clubhouse (west wall), Steel Plate shooting pit, and the Rifle range. Attached below are pictures of the locations of the stop the bleed kits.
