For your safety the club has installed “Stop The Bleed” trauma mitigation kits. The “Stop The Bleed” kits are designed to provide their users with immediate access to products that slow traumatic hemorrhaging before professional help can arrive. The kits includes the following items the following life saving components; CAT tourniquet Emergency bandage, Latex gloves, Trauma shears, Permanent marker, and Printed instructions They have been installed in the following four locations through out the club facility.
